The fifth one said

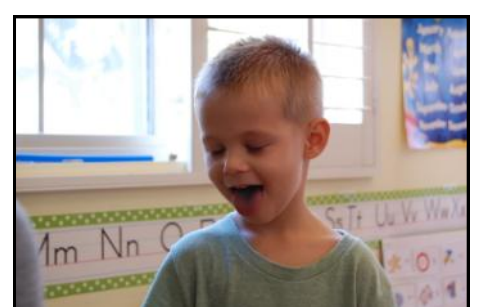
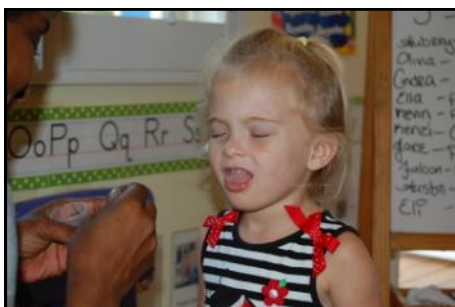
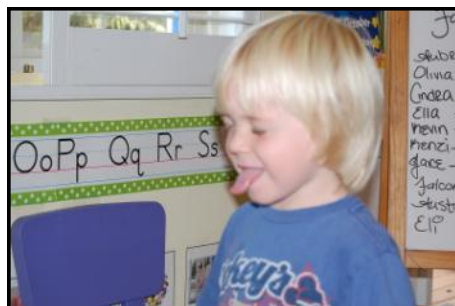
"Isn't Halloween fun!".
